
I have only had this experience with the <u>mushic mostly</u> and my holiday is over but I am planning my next trip to the jungle to see if I can track it down again and learn more about it.







I need to get rid of them: if that is possible. I tried keeping calm. what is happening in the future. I need to be fearless and help!




