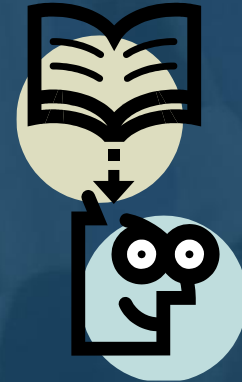
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Of course, history wasn't the only thing that ensured the success of these people, but certainly the life skills gained from the subject would have played a big part!

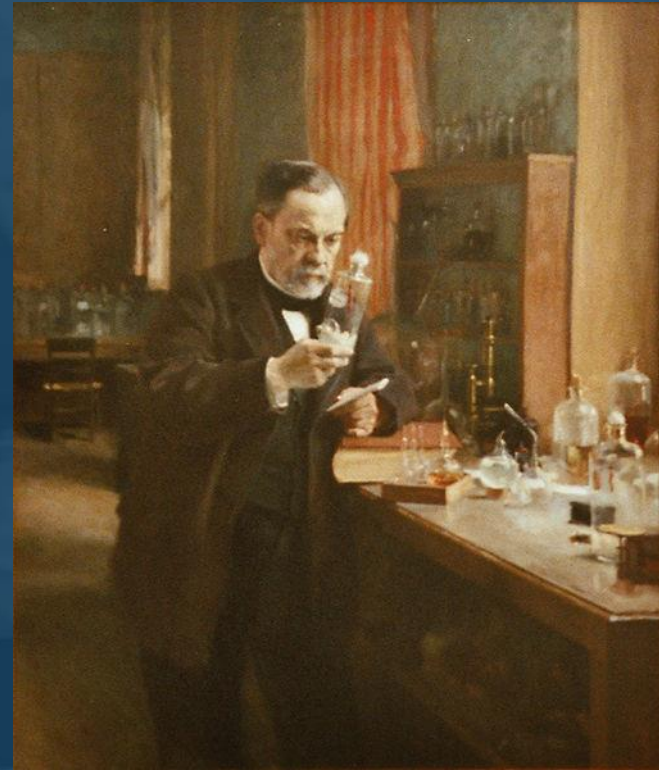
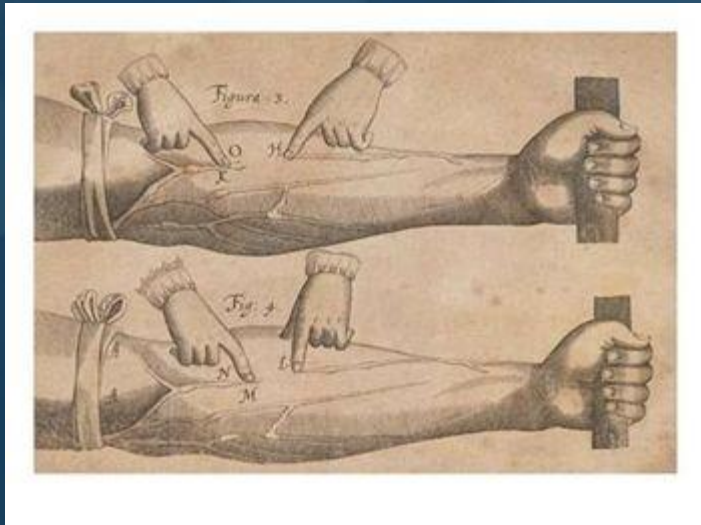
